## Important Information for those ARTC members on the Teachers' Retirement Board / United Healthcare Senior Supplement Plan.

Recently, we were made aware of some medical & vision claims being denied for payment by United Healthcare for those enrolled in the **UHC Senior Supplement Plan**. It appears to be a recurring issue in the processing of claims under the Medicare Supplement plan.

The reason being given to enrollees by United Healthcare service representatives is *"the enrollee has not met their 2022 deductible of \$2,233"*. <u>This is not</u> <u>correct!</u>

The deductible that is part of the Senior Supplement plan is the \$233 annual Medicare Part B deductible, and is paid by the Medicare enrollee first. After the \$233 deductible is met, Medicare pays their 80% of Medicare approved claims and the plan pays the remaining 20% minus any co-pays. The \$2,233 amount that is being referred to is the <u>Out-of-Pocket Maximum</u>. The remaining \$2,000 is not a deductible and is reached over time by an accumulation of plan co-pays. Once you reach the **Maximum Out-of-Pocket**, the plan typically pays **all** expenses beyond the Medicare payments.

> \$ 233 Medicare Part B deductible + \$ 2,000 accumulated plan co-pays

Total \$2,233 out of pocket maximum

If this situation happens to you, we suggest that you contact the TRB's escalation team for assistance *before* you pay for **any** Medical or Vision claims that have been denied under the **Senior Supplement plan**.
